Athletic Scholarships

Honors athletes, \$1,000.00 each (Boosters: 3 boys, 3 girls; Rackey: 2 girls)

These scholarships are one time grants, designated to assist students pursuing further education. The scholarships are intended to recognize outstanding graduating athletes and spirit team members at Albert Einstein High School. Applicants will be evaluated on the basis of their success, perseverance, dedication, sportsmanship, leadership, and academic achievement. **To be considered for a scholarship, student athletes, spirit team members, and team managers must meet the following criteria:**

- **Athletic Participation.** Applicant must be a 12th grade student in good standing at Albert Einstein High School who has participated on at least one varsity athletic team or spirit team during two (2) years while attending AEHS. Participation may be as a player, manager, trainer or statistician.
- **Academic Achievement.** Student must have a minimum cumulative un-weighted high school grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
- **Booster Club Membership.** Student's parent/guardian or other sponsor must be a current member of the Einstein Athletic Booster Club. Membership fee is a minimum of \$10.00 and up to \$100.00 per year and may be paid during the scholarship application period.
- **Leadership/Sportsmanship.** Applicants must have two coaches complete a brief recommendation form. If a student had only one coach, a second rec from an administrator or the athletic director will be accepted.
- **Higher Education.** Student must plan to enroll in an institution of higher learning within eight (8) months of graduation from AEHS. Such institutions include not only colleges and universities, but also technical and vocational schools.
- **Household Education History.** The Rackey scholarship is intended for girls who are the first female in their household to attend college.
- **Application Form.** Student must complete and submit on time application of the prescribed forms and a written personal narrative essay (see attachments).
- **Interview.** The Scholarship Committee will arrange interviews for those applicants considered finalists. The interview process is required and awardees will be chosen based on the written application and oral interview. Interviews will be arranged and scheduled for late April or early May.
- **Financial Need** is not a factor or consideration in applying for this scholarship.
- **Submission** The completed application form and essay must be delivered to the Booster Club mailbox in the Main Office PTSA mail box by 5 pm on March 18, 2017. Scholarship winners will be announced at the Senior Awards Ceremony in May. Each award will be made payable to the student upon proof of enrollment at an institution of higher learning. In the event the selected student fails to enroll and commence attendance at a qualifying institution within eight (8) months after graduation from AEHS, the scholarship will be forfeited. Funds may be used for tuition, books, instructional materials, on campus room and board.

Application Deadline is MARCH 18th!
